Huntington Catholic School will be offering a virtual option for the 2020-21 school year. We are asking that all families who are interested in this option complete the Google Form at the link listed below. We'll send out this Form before each semester begins in order to gather accurate totals for our school and classrooms. Also listed below under the Google Form are the details for our virtual learning experience. We are asking that all families interested in the virtual option complete the Google Form below by **Monday, August 3rd** in order to give us plenty of time for appropriate planning.

We are waiting on a few more details, depending on if our GEER grant is approved, that would change the livestreaming portion of this plan. All families choosing the virtual option would still need to complete the registration process just like a normal school year. We'll be sending out more information on our registration days early tomorrow morning. Please feel free to reach out if you have any questions.

Virtual Option Details

- Lessons would need to be posted by 9:00 AM each day on Sites (grades K-2) or Classroom (grades 3-8) when school is in session. The goal is to mirror what's being taught in the classroom as much as possible.
- Teacher lessons would be posted through a few different options: 1) Through a YouTube video or 2) Using our livestream technology once our webcams are installed.
- Students will need to show evidence of work each school day between 9:00 AM-3:00 PM. Attendance will be recorded daily and students are expected to check in throughout the day. Work cannot be done in the evenings or at night.
- It's vital that students adhere to assignment due dates unless there is an illness.
- Teachers will provide weekly feedback in a narrative format for K-2, in PowerSchool and on assignments for grades 3-8.
- Teachers will have "office hours" on certain days and times to video chat with students at home through Google Meet.
- If needed, students might have to come into the building for key assessments such as NWEA testing. We'll provide appropriate social distancing.
- We plan to offer opportunities for students to use Google Meet to interact with their classmates at times.



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- There will be opportunities to pick up/drop off supplies.
- Books and materials will be made available for pick up to be used at home.
- Devices can be rented to those signing our agreement form.
- Tuition agreements, policies, and practices will remain in effect and binding during and virtual learning period.
